### a note from administration...

We're already half way done with the first semester of school! Students finished their Q1 classes (2nd, 4th, and 6th period) on October 13th and final grades were posted to Tyler on Wednesday, October 28th. Here are the directions to view them in Tyler: Log in to Tyler, and you will see the grades section. The columns you want to look at are the "T1" (Term grade) and the "S1" (Semester grade). The Term and Semester will be the same IF the instructor did not give a Final Exam ("X1"). If they did, the grade MAY be different as the Semester will include the Final Exam (this semester grade will be the final grade put on the transcript). We will not be sending report cards at the end of each quarter. We will be entering final grades for all 7 of their classes on the transcripts at the end of December.

Now that students have started Q2, they are taking 4 classes (1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th period), which means that the advisory schedule has changed. Students will now meet with their advisors once a week: every Wednesday at 9:00 AM. We have a few days off this month, so we have noted some important dates on this page.
