The PSAT is Wednesday October 9th here on DATA's school campus. All 10th graders are signed up to test as well as any 11th graders that signed up with Ms. Rael. The link below shows who is testing and what room they are testing in. If anyone isn't on the list that thinks they should be, please contact Ms. Rael at <u>alix.rael@datacharter.org</u>. All students will need to be at school at 8am per usual and testing will be done around 11a.

Students will not be dismissed from their test sessions early. Therefore, it is important for them to bring a book, homework, etc. to fill the time if they finish early. Their phones will be taken at the start of the test and they won't be returned until the entire test is done so that won't be an option to fill the time.

No Phones, Ear Buds, Headphones, Smart Watches, or any other electronics will have to be turned in to the test proctor at the start of the test. Students won't get them back until the end of testing. They will not be allowed to use them during break or if they finish their test early.
